Developing personal and collective power through closer connection to Nature



Landscapes are an important source of personal and collective power. Landscapes, and topography in particular, have the potential to sustain life, promote prosperity, and enhance personal accomplishments. They often determine the character of a people, and are of fundamental importance in terms of physical and psychological well-being. Traditional peoples around the world have therefore developed complex techniques for identifying, cultivating, and tapping into this ample source of power.

COURSE OVERVIEW

Feng shui is most commonly associated with the arrangement of objects in a room. But feng shui expert Alex Stark takes us deeper into these ancient techniques to show us how immersion into the landscapes that surround us can help us connect directly with unlimited sources of power to increase ability, performance, and satisfaction in every area of life. These techniques include visual observation, dowsing, earth-based rituals, and pilgrimages to places of power.

Through the practice of these techniques, and by connecting more directly to the Earth and its power, Stark guides us to "walk fully with the dragon" of our personal power once again, cultivating our capacity to create positive change for ourself and our global community.
